

IMPORTANCE OF EXPERIENCE IN AGRICULTURE

"In agriculture, experience is more valuable than more education. When experience and knowledge are combined, it gives momentum for agriculture progress and to achieve the desired objectives" said Krishi Pandit Shri Narayanbhai Chawda while inaugurating a two-day state level conference of Agril. Asstt. Association at Raipur.

He emphasized the role and importance of agriculture assistants in agriculture development. In addition the points will also be discussed as to how to increase the existing level of production.

The Secretary of this association, Shri B.B. Singh narrated at length that the demands of Agriculture Assistant are ignored by the Government and united suggestions from the delegates to overcome this problem.
